HOUSE BILL No. 1230

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning professions and occupations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 25-1-9.5-3.5, AS AMENDED BY P.L.207-2021,
SECTION 25, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
JULY 1, 2022]: Sec. 3.5. As used in this chapter, "practitioner" means
an individual who holds an unlimited license to practice as any of the
following in Indiana:
(1) An athletic trainer licensed under IC 25-5.1.
(2) A chiropractor licensed under IC 25-10.
(3) A dental hygienist licensed under IC 25-13.
(4) The following:
(A) A dentist licensed under IC 25-14.
(B) An individual who holds a dental residency permit issued
under IC 25-14-1-5.
(C) An individual who holds a dental faculty license under
IC 25-14-1-5.5.
(5) A diabetes educator licensed under IC 25-14.3.
(6) A dietitian licensed under IC 25-14.5.
(7) A genetic counselor licensed under IC 25-17.3.
