Additions: Whenever a new statutory provision is being enacted (or a new constitutional provision adopted), the text of the new provision will appear in **this style type**. Also, the word **NEW** will appear in that style type in the introductory clause of each SECTION that adds a new provision to the Indiana Code or the Indiana Constitution.

HOUSE ENROLLED ACT No. 1235

AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning agriculture and animals.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 15-16-2-1.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2017]: Sec. 1.5. (a) As used in this section, "manure based fertilizer" means processed manure based commercial fertilizer with a manure content of at least seventy-five percent (75%).

- (b) Except as provided in subsection (c) and sections 35 and 36 of this chapter, this chapter does not apply to manure based fertilizer.
 - (c) The state chemist shall adopt rules under IC 4-22-2:
 - (1) regulating the distribution of manure based fertilizer; and
 - (2) establishing fees for the distribution of manure based fertilizer.
