DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 12-7-2-32.5; IC 12-15-15.5.

Synopsis: Medicaid reimbursement for children's hospitals. Requires the office of the secretary of family and social services to establish a pilot program to reimburse under Medicaid a children's hospital located in Chicago, Illinois, for Medicaid covered services provided to a qualifying Medicaid recipient at the same reimbursement rate at which the office reimburses a children's hospital located in Indiana.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning Medicaid.
