DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Synopsis: State purchasing. Requires the Indiana department of administration to prepare an annual report, beginning July 1, 2023, regarding purchases made by state agencies from the following: (1) A minority business enterprise. (2) A nonprofit agency for individuals with disabilities. (3) A veteran owned small business. (4) A women's business enterprise.

Effective: July 1, 2022.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state offices and administration.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

14	Sec. 2. Beginning July 1, 2023, and every July 1 thereafter, the
15	department shall prepare a report regarding purchases made by
16	state agencies from diversity businesses during the most recently
17	concluded state fiscal year.

2	contain the following information:
3	(1) For each diversity business from which a purchase was

33	(3) Specific information and examples relating to the reasons
34	state agencies have not purchased supplies and services from
35	diversity businesses, such as any of the following:
36	(A) Supplies or services needed by state agencies are not
37	provided by diversity businesses.
38	(B) Supplies or services do not meet specifications.
39	(C) Supplies or services cannot be provided at a fair

41	Sec. 4. The department may provide information in the report,
42	other than information described in section 3 of this chapter, that

2	Sec. 5. The department shall submit a copy of the report
3	required by this chapter to each of the following, not later than
4	September 1 of each year:
5	(1) The general assembly in an electronic format under
6	IC 5-14-6.
7	(2) The governor.
8	(3) The governor's commission on supplier diversity
9	established by IC 4-13-16.5-2.
10	(4) The committee for the purchase of products and services
11	of individuals with a disability created by IC 16-32-2-2.
