DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 8-14-2-9; IC 8-23-23-5.

Synopsis: Lane elimination or reduction and road funding. Provides that a county, city, or town that either eliminates or reduces the width of a lane of road or street will have a percentage of the money distributed from the local road and street account reduced for the following year. Specifies that the percentage of distribution reduced is based upon the years of use of the lane and the length of the elimination or width reduction of the lane. Provides for a maximum percentage of distribution reduction. Provides that the section does not apply to temporary lane closures and width reductions. Provides that the Indiana department of transportation (department) when notified in writing shall inspect the lane for elimination or width reduction. Provides that the department will notify the auditor of the state of the percentage of distribution to be withheld. Provides that the department may adopt rules. Provides that a county, city, or town with a road or street construction project that eliminates or reduces a lane is ineligible for state and federal funding and grants for the project.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 8-14-2-9 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE

3	1, 2021]: Sec. 9. (a) If after June 30, 2021, a county, city, or town:

7	then a percentage of the distribution from the local road and street
8	account for the county, city, or town is reduced for the following
9	year.
10	(b) Subject to the limitations in subsections (c) and (d), a
11	percentage of the distribution from the local road and street
12	account is reduced for the following year if the county, city, or
13	town does any of the following:
14	(1) Eliminates a lane of road or street that has been in use for
15	twenty (20) years or more. The distribution is reduced by five
16	percent (5%) for each twenty-five hundredths (0.25) of mile
17	lane eliminated.



1 (2) Eliminates a lane of road or street that has been in use for 2 less than twenty (20) years. The distribution is reduced by two 3 percent (2%) for each twenty-five hundredths (0.25) of mile 4 lane eliminated. 5 (3) Eliminates a lane of road or street, regardless of the years 6 of use, by twenty-five hundredths (0.25) of a mile or less. The 7 distribution is reduced by one percent (1%). 8 (4) Reduces the width of a lane of road or street that has been 9 in use for twenty (20) years or more. The distribution is 10 reduced by one percent (1%) for each twenty-five hundredths 11 (0.25) of mile lane narrowed. 12 (5) Reduces the width of a lane of road or street that has been 13 in use for less than twenty (20) years. The distribution is 14 reduced by one-half of one percent (0.5%) for each 15 twenty-five hundredths (0.25) of mile lane narrowed. 16 (6) Reduces the width of a lane of road or street, regardless of 17 the years of use, for less than twenty-five hundredths (0.25) of 18 a mile. The distribution is reduced by one-quarter of one 19 percent (0.25%). 20 (c) The maximum percentage reduction of the local road and 21 street account for a county, city, or town under this section is 22 twenty percent (20%). 23 (d) This section does not apply to lane closures and lane width 24 reductions that are temporary in nature, including temporary lane 25 closures and lane width reductions for road and street 26 construction, repair, resurfacing, restoration, and rehabilitation. 27 (e) The department shall prescribe forms for the 28 implementation of this section. 29 (f) If notified in writing, the department shall inspect the lane of 30 road or street. If the department determines that an elimination of 31 a lane or a reduction of lane width has occurred under this section, 32 the department shall notify the auditor of the state of the 33 percentage of distribution from the local road and street account 34 for the county, city, or town to be reduced. 35 (g) The department may adopt rules under IC 4-22-2, including 36 emergency rules under IC 4-22-2-37.1, as necessary to implement 37 this section. 38 SECTION 2. IC 8-23-23-5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE 39 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 40 1, 2021]: Sec. 5. (a) This section does not apply to lane closures and 41 lane width reductions that are temporary in nature, including 42 temporary lane closures and lane width reductions for road and



1 street construction, repair, resurfacing, restoration, and 2 rehabilitation. 3 (b) Subject to the limitations in subsection (a), any road or street 4 construction project after June 30, 2021, for a county, city, or town 5 that: 6 (1) eliminates a lane of road or street; or 7 (2) reduces the width of a lane of road or street by more than 8 three (3) feet; 9 is ineligible for state or federal funding, including state or federal 10 grants and matching grants, for the road or street construction

11 project.
