DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 6-3-3-14.

Synopsis: Teacher tax credit. Provides that an individual employed as a teacher is entitled to a credit against the individual's adjusted gross income tax liability for amounts expended on classroom supplies up to a maximum of \$200 per taxable year.

Effective: January 1, 2015 (retroactive).

HOUSE BILL No. 1247

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning taxation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 6-3-3-14 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2015 (RETROACTIVE)]: Sec. 14. (a) As used in this section, "classroom supplies" means any items that qualify for the educator expense deduction under Section 62(a)(2)(D) of the Internal Revenue Code (as effective December 31, 2013).

(b) Each taxable year, an individual employed as a teacher (as defined in IC 20-18-2-22(a)) is entitled to a credit against the individual's adjusted gross income tax liability for amounts expended during the taxable year for classroom supplies. The amount of the credit is the lesser of:

(1) two hundred dollars (\$200); or

(2) the total amount expended for classroom supplies during a taxable year.

(c) The credit provided by this section may not exceed the



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amount of the individual's adjusted gross income tax liability for 1 2 the taxable year, reduced by the sum of all credits for the taxable 3 year that are applied before the application of the credit provided 4 by this section. The amount of any unused credit under this section 5 for a taxable year may not be carried forward to a succeeding 6 taxable year, carried back to a preceding taxable year, or 7 refunded. 8 SECTION 2. [EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2015 (RETROACTIVE)] 9 (a) IC 6-3-3-14, as added by this act, applies to taxable years 10 beginning after December 31, 2014. 11 (b) This SECTION expires January 1, 2018.

12 SECTION 3. An emergency is declared for this act.



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
