DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 16-18-2; IC 16-42-5.1.

Synopsis: Mobile retail food establishments. Requires a local health department to: (1) establish standards for the issuance of a mobile retail food establishment permit (permit) and the inspection and operation of a mobile retail food establishment; (2) prescribe a permit application form; and (3) establish an annual permit fee and inspection fee. Requires a local health department, not later than January 1, 2025, to begin: (1) receiving applications for mobile retail food establishments; (2) collecting annual permit fees and inspection fees; (3) issuing mobile retail food establishment permits; and (4) conducting inspections of mobile retail food establishments. Sets forth limitations on permit fees and inspection fees. Provides that, beginning January 1, 2025, a person may not operate a mobile retail food establishment within the jurisdiction of a local health department unless the person obtains a permit from the local health department.
