### DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: Noncode.

**Synopsis:** Study of low head dams and riparian rights. Urges the legislative council to assign to an appropriate interim study committee the task of studying: (1) low head dams; and (2) riparian rights; during the 2019 interim.

Effective: Upon passage.

### **HOUSE BILL No. 1265**

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning natural resources.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) As used in this
2	SECTION, "low head dam" means a manmade obstruction that:
3	(1) typically spans a river from bank to bank;
4	(2) is usually below the surface of the river, with river water
5	flowing across the entire length of the top of the dam; and
6	(3) can, under certain flow conditions, create strong
7	turbulence and recirculating currents that make escape
8	nearly impossible for anyone thrown into the water on the
9	downstream side of the dam.
10	(b) As used in this SECTION, "riparian rights" means legal
11	rights that:
12	(1) arise from the ownership of property that abuts a river,
13	stream, or lake; and
14	(2) relate to the use and enjoyment of the river, stream, or
15	lake.
16	(c) The legislative council is urged to assign to an appropriate
17	interim study committee the task of studying:
18	(1) low head dams; and

- (2) riparian rights;
  during the 2019 interim.
  (d) This SECTION expires January 1, 2020.
  SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.
