HOUSE BILL No. 1267

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 3-8-5-14.5; IC 3-10-6-12.5.

Synopsis: Municipal election candidate withdrawal. Extends the deadline for a candidate nominated by a town convention to withdraw from the municipal election from three days after the adjournment of the convention.

Effective: July 1, 2020.

HOUSE BILL No. 1267

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning elections.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 3-8-5-14.5, AS AMENDED BY P.L.278-2019,
SECTION 26, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
JULY 1, 2020]: Sec. 14.5. (a) A town election board or circuit court
clerk conducting a municipal election under IC 3-10-7 may not include
the name of a candidate nominated by a town convention on the
municipal election ballot if the person files a notice to withdraw with
the clerk. The circuit court clerk shall notify the town election board of
any candidate withdrawal filed under this subsection not later than the
deadline for the clerk to file a copy of the certification of nomination
under section 13(e) of this chapter.
(b) The notice to withdraw must:
(1) be signed and acknowledged before an officer authorized to
take acknowledgments of deeds;
(2) have the certificate of acknowledgment appended to the
notice; and
(3) be filed with the clerk no later than noon three (3) ten (10)
days following the adjournment of the convention.
