

HOUSE BILL No. 1267

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 3-8-5-14.5; IC 3-10-6-12.5.

Synopsis: Municipal election candidate withdrawal. Extends the deadline for a candidate nominated by a town convention to withdraw from the municipal election from three days after the adjournment of the convention to ten days after the adjournment of the convention.

Effective: July 1, 2020.

HOUSE BILL No. 1267

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning elections.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 3-8-5-14.5, AS AMENDED BY P.L.278-2019,
2 SECTION 26, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 2020]: Sec. 14.5. (a) A town election board or circuit court
4 clerk conducting a municipal election under IC 3-10-7 may not include
5 the name of a candidate nominated by a town convention on the
6 municipal election ballot if the person files a notice to withdraw with
7 the clerk. The circuit court clerk shall notify the town election board of
8 any candidate withdrawal filed under this subsection not later than the
9 deadline for the clerk to file a copy of the certification of nomination
10 under section 13(e) of this chapter.
11 (b) The notice to withdraw must:
12 (1) be signed and acknowledged before an officer authorized to
13 take acknowledgments of deeds;
14 (2) have the certificate of acknowledgment appended to the
15 notice; and
16 (3) be filed with the clerk no later than noon ~~three (3)~~ **ten (10)**
17 days following the adjournment of the convention.



1 SECTION 2. IC 3-10-6-12.5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2020]: Sec. 12.5. (a) This section
3 applies to a candidate:

4 (1) of a political party that is not a major political party; and

5 (2) nominated by a convention under section 12 of this chapter.

6 (b) A county election board may not include the name of a candidate
7 on the municipal election ballot if the person files a notice to withdraw
8 with the board. The notice must:

9 (1) be signed and acknowledged before an officer authorized to
10 take acknowledgments of deeds;

11 (2) have the certificate of acknowledgment appended to the
12 notice; and

13 (3) be filed with the board not later than noon ~~three (3)~~ **ten (10)**
14 days after the adjournment of the convention.
