

## **HOUSE BILL No. 1275**

DIGEST OF HB 1275 (Updated January 24, 2018 2:20 pm - DI 84)

Citations Affected: IC 33-33.

**Synopsis:** Magistrates in Scott County and Jefferson County. Allows the judges of the Jefferson County circuit and superior courts to appoint a magistrate to serve the Jefferson County courts. Allows the judges of the Scott County circuit and superior courts to appoint a magistrate to serve the Scott County courts.

Effective: July 1, 2018.

## **HOUSE BILL No. 1275**

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning courts and court officers.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 33-33-39-1, AS AMENDED BY P.L.127-2008,
SECTION 13, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
JULY 1, 2018]: Sec. 1. (a) Jefferson County constitutes the fifth
judicial circuit.

- (b) The judges of the Jefferson circuit court and Jefferson superior court may jointly appoint one (1) full-time magistrate under IC 33-23-5 to serve the circuit and superior courts.
- (c) The magistrate continues in office until removed by the judges of the Jefferson circuit and superior courts.
- SECTION 2. IC 33-33-72-1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2018]: Sec. 1. (a) Scott County constitutes the sixth judicial circuit.
- (b) The judges of the Scott circuit court and Scott superior court may jointly appoint one (1) full-time magistrate under IC 33-23-5 to serve the circuit and superior courts.
- (c) The magistrate continues in office until removed by the judges of the Scott circuit and superior courts.
