### **HOUSE BILL No. 1279**

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning natural and cultural resources.

#### Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 14-33-2-2 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2019]: Sec. 2. A petition filed
under section 1 of this chapter must be signed by freeholders owning
land in the proposed district in the minimum number or proportion of
all the freeholders in the proposed district as follows:
(1) Districts of not more than <del>one thousand (1,000)</del> five thousand
(5,000) freeholds, thirty percent (30%) of the freeholders.
(2) Districts of at least one thousand one (1,001) and not more
than five thousand (5,000) freeholds, fifteen percent (15%) of the
freeholders but not less than three hundred (300) signatures.
(3) (2) Districts of at least five thousand one $(5,001)$ and not more
than twenty-five thousand $(25,000)$ freeholds, ten percent $(10\%)$
fifteen percent (15%) of the freeholders but not less than seven
hundred fifty (750) one thousand (1,000) signatures.
(4) (3) Districts of at least twenty-five thousand one (25,001)
freeholds, <del>five percent (5%)</del> ten percent (10%) of the freeholders
but not less than two thousand five hundred (2,500) three

thousand (3,000) signatures.
