## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 9-20-6.

**Synopsis:** Overweight truck permits. Provides that the Indiana department of transportation may issue an overweight permit for transporting overweight vehicles and loads carrying resources to and from an industry that is critical to Indiana's economy on certain highways in the state highway system. Makes a conforming amendment.

Effective: July 1, 2020.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

11	apply to a highway under a local authority's jurisdiction.
12	(b) Subject to subsections (c) and (d), the Indiana department of
13	transportation may, upon proper application in writing and upon
14	good cause shown, grant a permit for transporting overweight
15	vehicles and loads carrying resources to and from an industry that
16	is critical to Indiana's economy on a highway in the state highway
17	system, including state maintained routes through cities and towns.
18	(c) A permit granted under this section may be used only on
19	designated highways within the state highway system, avoiding
20	highways under a local authority's jurisdiction.
21	(d) An application for a permit under this section must
22	demonstrate the following:
23	(1) Rail transportation is not an option for transporting the
24	resources.
25	(2) Other transportation options that do not include travel
26	using a permit under this section have been exhausted.
27	(3) As a result of the lack of transportation options for this
28	resource, supply chain interruptions or supply dock back logs
29	exist.
30	(e) A permit issued under this section may designate the route
31	to be traversed and may contain any other restrictions or
32	conditions required for the safe movement of the vehicle.
33	(f) The Indiana department of transportation shall adopt rules
34	under IC 4-22-2, including emergency rules in the manner
35	provided under IC 4-22-2-37.1, for the issuance, fee structure, and
36	enforcement of a permit under this section.
