HOUSE BILL No. 1287

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning environmental law.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 13-12-7 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS
2	A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3	1, 2022]:
4	Chapter 7. Indiana Climate Change Mitigation and Resilience
5	Commission
6	Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "commission" refers to the
7	Indiana climate change mitigation and resilience commission
8	established by section 2 of this chapter.
9	Sec. 2. The Indiana climate change mitigation and resilience
10	commission is established.
11	Sec. 3. The commission consists of thirteen (13) members,
12	appointed as follows:
13	(1) Four (4) members of the general assembly who are
14	appointed under section 5 of this chapter.
15	(2) Two (2) members who have broad experience in electric
16	utility policy appointed by the governor. At least one (1) of the
17	members appointed under this subdivision must represent



1	utility ratepayers.
	(3) One (1) member from Purdue University's Climate
2 3	Research Center appointed by the governor.
4	(4) One (1) member from Indiana University's Environmental
5	Resilience Institute appointed by the governor.
6	(5) One (1) member who has expertise in renewable energy
7	technology and deployment appointed by the governor.
8	(6) One (1) member who is a representative of the Indiana
9	Farm Bureau appointed by the governor.
10	(7) The chairperson of the board of the Indiana economic
11	development corporation or the chairperson's designee.
12	(8) The commissioner of the department or the
12	commissioner's designee.
14	(9) The director of the department of natural resources or the
15	director's designee.
16	Sec. 4. Members of the commission appointed under section 3(2)
17	through 3(9) of this chapter serve a four (4) year term.
18	Sec. 5. (a) Four (4) members of the general assembly shall be
19	appointed as members of the commission as follows:
20	(1) The president pro tempore of the senate shall appoint one
$\frac{1}{21}$	(1) member of the senate who shall serve as co-chair of the
22	commission.
23	(2) The minority leader of the senate shall appoint one (1)
24	member of the senate.
25	(3) The speaker of the house of representatives shall appoint
26	one (1) member of the house of representatives.
27	(4) The minority leader of the house of representatives shall
28	appoint one (1) member of the house of representatives who
29	shall serve as co-chair of the commission.
30	(b) A member of the commission appointed under subsection (a)
31	serves until the member's current term of office as a member of the
32	general assembly expires.
33	(c) A vacancy under subsection (a) shall be filled by the officer
34	who appointed the vacating legislator. A legislative member
35	appointed under this subsection serves until the end of the
36	unexpired term of the vacating legislator.
37	(d) A member of the commission appointed under this section
38	may be reappointed.
39	Sec. 6. Seven (7) members of the commission constitute a
40	quorum.
41	Sec. 7. The commission is responsible for making all policy
42	decisions relating to the duties and powers of the commission.



1 Sec. 8. The department shall staff the commission. 2 Sec. 9. (a) Each member of the commission who is not a state 3 employee is entitled to the minimum salary per diem provided by 4 IC 4-10-11-2.1(b). The member is also entitled to reimbursement 5 for traveling expenses as provided under IC 4-13-1-4 and other 6 expenses actually incurred in connection with the member's duties 7 as provided in the state policies and procedures established by the 8 Indiana department of administration and approved by the budget 9 agency. Expenses incurred under this subsection shall be paid out 10 of the funds appropriated to the lieutenant governor. 11 (b) Each member of the commission who is a state employee but 12 who is not a member of the general assembly is entitled to 13 reimbursement for traveling expenses as provided under 14 IC 4-13-1-4 and other expenses actually incurred in connection 15 with the member's duties as provided in the state policies and 16 procedures established by the Indiana department of 17 administration and approved by the budget agency. 18 (c) Each member of the commission who is a member of the 19 general assembly is entitled to receive the same per diem, mileage, 20 and travel allowances paid to members of the general assembly 21 serving on interim study committees established by the legislative 22 council. 23 Sec. 10. (a) The purposes of the commission are to study climate 24 change impacts on Indiana, as well as resilience and carbon 25 mitigation policies. 26 (b) The commission shall develop recommendations in the 27 following areas: 28 (1) Policies that encourage the growth of renewable energy. 29 (2) Policies in support of resilience measures that will help 30 protect Indiana's communities and infrastructure. 31 (3) Policies to address the projected impacts on Indiana's 32 agricultural sector. 33 (4) Policies to help grow Indiana's clean energy 34 manufacturing sector, including the manufacture of: 35 (A) electric vehicle; 36 (B) wind turbine; and 37 (C) solar panel; 38 components. 39 (5) A plan for decreasing the greenhouse gas emissions from 40 motor vehicles owned and operated in Indiana, including a 41 plan for increasing the number of registered electric vehicles.

(6) The development of policies to increase:

5	activities across Indiana.
6	(7) Other policies as determined by the commission to be
7	necessary for the development of a comprehensive climate
8	change mitigation and resilience plan for Indiana.
9	Sec. 11. (a) The commission shall submit an annual report to the
10	executive director of the legislative services agency for distribution
11	to the members of the general assembly.
12	(b) The report must include a description of:
13	(1) all activities undertaken by the commission during the
14	prior state fiscal year; and
15	(2) the recommendations developed under section 10(b) of this
16	chapter.
17	(c) The commission shall submit the report:
18	(1) not later than December 1 of each year; and
19	(2) in an electronic format under IC 5-14-6.
20	Sec. 12. This chapter expires December 31, 2030.
