## **HOUSE BILL No. 1300**

## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 5-14-3.4.

**Synopsis:** State grants data base. Requires the Indiana department of administration (department) and the office of technology to create a state grants website to serve as a central location for information on grants administered by executive branch state agencies. Requires an executive branch state agency to provide grant information to the department before commencing a grant solicitation or award process.

Effective: July 1, 2023.

## **HOUSE BILL No. 1300**

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state and local administration.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 5-14-3.4 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2	AS A <b>NEW</b> CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3	JULY 1, 2023]:
4	Chapter 3.4. State Grants Data Base
5	Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "executive state agency" has the
6	meaning set forth in IC 5-14-3.3-2.
7	Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "grant" means the allocation of
8	financial assistance funds by an executive state agency through a
9	competitive or first-come, first-served award process, including
0	allocation of federal financial assistance funds administered by an
1	executive state agency. The term does not include:
2	(1) the procurement of goods or services for an executive state
3	agency; or
4	(2) the acquisition, construction, alteration, improvement, or
5	repair of real property for an executive state agency.
6	Sec. 3. As used in this chapter, "website" means the state grants
7	website created and administered under section 4 of this chapter

1	Sec. 4. Not later than January 1, 2024, the Indiana department
2	of administration and the office of technology established by
3	IC 4-13.1-2-1 shall create and administer a website that:
4	(1) provides a central location for grant information;
5	(2) is accessible through the department's website; and
6	(3) meets the standards set forth in IC 5-14-3.3.
7	Sec. 5. After December 31, 2023, an executive state agency may
8	not commence a grant solicitation or grant award process until the
9	executive state agency provides the department with the following
10	information:
11	(1) The grant:
12	(A) title; and
13	(B) identification number.
14	(2) The grant's revenue source.
15	(3) The grant's purpose.
16	(4) A brief description of the grant.
17	(5) Any eligibility requirements, including required matching
18	funds.
19	(6) Any geographic limitations on the grant.
20	(7) A description of the:
21	(A) total available grant funding;
22	(B) number of grant awards; and
23	(C) amount per grant award.
24	(8) The period of time covered by the grant.
25	(9) The date the grant will be issued.
26	(10) The deadline for submission of grant applications.
27	(11) The Internet address for electronic submission of grant
28	applications, if applicable.
29	(12) The contact information for the executive state agency
30	employee responsible for communicating grant requirements.
31	Sec. 6. Not later than five (5) business days after receipt of the
32	information under section 5 of this chapter, the department shall
33	post information on the website. An executive state agency shall
34	immediately notify the department of any subsequent changes in
35	grant information. The department shall regularly update the
36	website to maintain the accuracy of the grant information.
37	Sec. 7. An executive state agency shall provide a link on the
38	executive state agency's website to the state grants website.
39	Nothing in this chapter prohibits an executive state agency from
40	maintaining grant information on the executive state agency's own
