

HOUSE BILL No. 1305

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 33-37-2-3.

Synopsis: Payment of court fees. Allows a court to reduce some or all of the court costs owed by a person who performs community service or uncompensated volunteer work by: (1) determining the number of hours of community service or volunteer work performed by the person; (2) multiplying the number of hours worked by the Indiana minimum wage; and (3) deducting that figure from the amount owed.

Effective: July 1, 2018.

HOUSE BILL No. 1305

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning courts and court officers.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 33-37-2-3, AS AMENDED BY P.L.156-2007,
2 SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 2018]: Sec. 3. (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), when
4 the court imposes costs, it shall conduct a hearing to determine whether
5 the convicted person is indigent. If the person is not indigent, the court
6 shall order the person to pay:
7 (1) the entire amount of the costs at the time sentence is
8 pronounced;
9 (2) the entire amount of the costs at some later date; ~~or~~
10 (3) specified parts of the costs at designated intervals; ~~or~~
11 **(4) the entire amount of the costs at some later date, less any**
12 **amount credited under subsection (g) for the performance of:**
13 **(A) community service work ordered by the court; or**
14 **(B) uncompensated volunteer work at a nonprofit or**
15 **municipal corporation that benefits the community, even**
16 **if the volunteer work is not ordered by the court.**
17 (b) A court may impose costs and suspend payment of all or part of



1 the costs until the convicted person has completed all or part of the
 2 sentence. If the court suspends payment of the costs, the court shall
 3 conduct a hearing at the time the costs are due to determine whether the
 4 convicted person is indigent. If the convicted person is not indigent, the
 5 court shall order the convicted person to pay the costs:

6 (1) at the time the costs are due; or

7 (2) in a manner set forth in subsection (a)(2) through ~~(a)(3)~~;

8 **(a)(4).**

9 (c) If a court suspends payment of costs under subsection (b), the
 10 court retains jurisdiction over the convicted person until the convicted
 11 person has paid the entire amount of the costs.

12 (d) Upon any default in the payment of the costs:

13 (1) an attorney representing the county may bring an action on a
 14 debt for the unpaid amount;

15 (2) the court may direct that the person, if the person is not
 16 indigent, be committed to the county jail and credited toward
 17 payment at the rate of twenty dollars (\$20) for each twenty-four
 18 (24) hour period the person is confined, until the amount paid
 19 plus the amount credited equals the entire amount due; or

20 (3) the court may institute contempt proceedings to enforce the
 21 court's order for payment of the costs.

22 (e) If, after a hearing under subsection (a) or (b), the court
 23 determines that a convicted person is able to pay part of the costs of
 24 representation, the court shall order the person to pay an amount of not
 25 more than the cost of the defense services rendered on behalf of the
 26 person. The clerk shall deposit the amount paid by a convicted person
 27 under this subsection in the county's supplemental public defender
 28 services fund established under IC 33-40-3-1.

29 (f) A person ordered to pay part of the cost of representation under
 30 subsection (e) has the same rights and protections as those of other
 31 judgment debtors under the Constitution of the State of Indiana and
 32 Indiana law.

33 **(g) A court may reduce some or all of the costs owed by a person
 34 who has performed court ordered community service work or
 35 uncompensated volunteer work at a nonprofit or municipal
 36 corporation that benefits the community, even if the volunteer
 37 work is not ordered by a court. The maximum reduction shall be
 38 determined as follows:**

39 **STEP ONE: Determine the number of hours of community
 40 service or uncompensated volunteer work satisfactorily
 41 performed by the person.**

42 **STEP TWO: Multiply the number determined in STEP ONE**



1 by the amount of the Indiana minimum wage established by
2 IC 22-2-2.
3 **STEP THREE: Subtract the product determined under STEP**
4 **TWO from the costs owed by the person.**
5 **A person's costs may not be reduced below zero (0).**
