DIGEST OF HB 1305 (Updated February 3, 2021 1:55 pm - DI 140)

Citations Affected: IC 12-7; IC 12-15.

Synopsis: Medicaid reimbursement for children's hospitals. Specifies the reimbursement rate for inpatient and outpatient Medicaid services that are provided by an out of state children's hospital located in a state bordering Indiana.

Effective: July 1, 2021.

HOUSE BILL No. 1305

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning Medicaid.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 12-7-2-32.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2	AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3	1, 2021]: Sec. 32.5. "Children's hospital", for purposes of
4	IC 12-15-15-1.2, has the meaning set forth in IC 12-15-15-1.2(a).
5	SECTION 2. IC 12-15-1.2 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
6	CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
7	[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 1.2. (a) As used in this section,
8	"children's hospital" means:
9	(1) a freestanding general acute care hospital that:
10	(A) is designated by the Medicare program as a children's
11	hospital; or
12	(B) furnishes inpatient and outpatient health care services
13	to patients who are predominantly individuals less than
14	nineteen (19) years of age; or
15	(2) a facility located within a freestanding general acute care
16	hospital that:
17	(A) is designated by the Medicare program as a children's

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1 hospital; or 2 (B) furnishes inpatient and outpatient health care services 3 to patients who are predominately individuals less than 4 nineteen (19) years of age. 5 (b) This section applies to reimbursement for inpatient 6 Medicaid services and outpatient Medicaid services provided to a 7 Medicaid recipient who is less than nineteen (19) years of age at a 8 children's hospital that is located in a state bordering Indiana. 9 (c) The office shall reimburse a children's hospital for covered 10 services provided to a Medicaid recipient that is described in 11 subsection (b) at a rate set by the secretary that is based on a 12 reimbursement formula that is: 13 comparable to the current federal Medicare (1) 14 reimbursement rate for the service provided by the children's 15 hospital; or 16 (2) one hundred thirty percent (130%) of the Medicaid 17 reimbursement rate for a service that does not have a 18 Medicare reimbursement rate. 19 (d) Before September 1, 2021, the office shall apply to the United 20 States Department of Health and Human Services for any state 21 plan amendment or Medicaid waiver necessary to implement and 22 administer this section. 23 (e) The office may adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 necessary for the 24 implementation of this section.
