Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: Township assistance. Urges the legislative council to assign to a study committee, in the 2015 interim, certain study topics related to the funding and delivery of township assistance in a township for which the township assistance property tax rate is more than 12 times the statewide average rate.

Effective: July 1, 2015.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

14	(e) This SECTION expires December 31, 2015.
