A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning taxation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) **The legislative**
2 **council is urged to assign to the appropriate study committee the**
3 **task of studying property tax exemptions, property tax deductions,**
4 **the stability of the property tax base, the cost of providing public**
5 **services that benefit property that is property tax exempt, and**
6 **whether a payment in lieu of taxes should be charged against**
7 **exempt property to fund the public services provided to the**
8 **property.**
9 (b) **This SECTION expires December 31, 2019.**
10 SECTION 2. **An emergency is declared for this act.**
