A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning taxation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) The legislative
2	council is urged to assign to the appropriate study committee the
3	task of studying property tax exemptions, property tax deductions,
4	the stability of the property tax base, the cost of providing public
5	services that benefit property that is property tax exempt, and
6	whether a payment in lieu of taxes should be charged against
7	exempt property to fund the public services provided to the
8	property.
9	(b) This SECTION expires December 31, 2019.
