

# HOUSE BILL No. 1313

## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 21-13-10.

**Synopsis:** Student loan assistance. Provides an annual grant award of \$2,500 to assist an individual with student loan debt for each consecutive year the individual is employed full time in a qualifying occupation in Indiana, not to exceed five years. Specifies that eligibility for a grant award begins on the first month of the first year that an individual is required to start repayment of a student loan, the proceeds of which were used to fund the individual's education. Makes an appropriation.

**Effective:** July 1, 2014.

## HOUSE BILL No. 1313

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning higher education and to make an appropriation.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 21-13-10 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE  
2 AS A **NEW** CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
3 JULY 1, 2014]:  
4 **Chapter 10. Student Loan Repayment Grant for Social  
5 Workers, Nurses, and Teachers**  
6 **Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "grant eligibility period" of an  
7 individual means a period of consecutive qualifying years  
8 beginning with the first month of the first qualifying year that the  
9 individual is required to begin making payments on a student loan  
10 and ending with the earlier of:**  
11 **(1) the last month of a qualifying year in which the individual  
12 pays the student loan in full; or**  
13 **(2) the last month of the fifth consecutive qualifying year.**  
14 **Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "qualifying occupation" means  
15 the following:**  
16 **(1) Social work.**



1           (2) Nursing.

2           (3) Teaching.

3           **Sec. 3. As used in this chapter, "qualifying year" means a twelve**  
4 **(12) month period in which an individual is required to make**  
5 **payments on a student loan.**

6           **Sec. 4. As used in this chapter, "student loan" means a qualified**  
7 **education loan (as defined in Section 221(d)(1) of the Internal**  
8 **Revenue Code), the proceeds of which were used to fund an**  
9 **individual's education.**

10          **Sec. 5. An individual employed in a qualifying occupation is**  
11 **entitled to a grant award during each qualifying year in an**  
12 **individual's grant eligibility period. The amount of the grant**  
13 **award for each qualifying year is equal to two thousand five**  
14 **hundred dollars (\$2,500) multiplied by the quotient of:**

15           (1) the number of weeks during the qualifying year in which  
16 the individual is employed on a full-time basis in a qualifying  
17 occupation; divided by

18           (2) fifty-two (52).

19          **Sec. 6. To receive a grant award under this chapter, an**  
20 **individual must apply to the commission for approval for each**  
21 **qualifying year for which the individual claims a grant award**  
22 **under section 5 of this chapter.**

23          **Sec. 7. The commission may adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 to**  
24 **administer this chapter.**

25          **Sec. 8. There is annually appropriated to the commission from**  
26 **the state general fund an amount sufficient for the purposes**  
27 **described in this chapter.**
