

HOUSE BILL No. 1320

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 5-22-8-1.5.

Synopsis: Purchases from youth agricultural programs. Raises the total amount of food that a public school or school corporation (purchasing agency) may purchase from a youth agricultural education program to \$10,000 per fiscal year. Specifies that if a purchasing agency purchases more than \$10,000 of food from a youth agricultural educational program per fiscal year, the purchasing agency must comply with the applicable federal procurement requirements.

Effective: July 1, 2022.

HOUSE BILL No. 1320

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 5-22-8-1.5, AS ADDED BY P.L.175-2021,
2 SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 2022]: Sec. 1.5. (a) This section applies to a purchase by a
4 purchasing agency that is a public school (as defined in IC 20-18-2-15)
5 or school corporation (as defined in IC 5-10.4-1-13).

6 (b) If a youth agricultural education program produces food, subject
7 to subsection (c), a purchasing agency may purchase up to ~~seven ten~~
8 thousand ~~five hundred~~ dollars (~~\$7,500~~) **(\$10,000)** of the food per fiscal
9 year from the youth agricultural education program. Nothing in this
10 section prohibits a purchasing agency from purchasing food from a
11 youth agricultural education program under any other procurement
12 requirement under this chapter.

13 (c) Subject to any rules or other restrictions adopted by the
14 purchasing agency, a purchase under ~~this section~~ **subsection (b)** is
15 considered a micro purchase and is subject to the documentation
16 provisions under 2 CFR 200 et seq.

17 **(d) If a purchasing agency purchases more than ten thousand**



1 **dollars (\$10,000) of food from a youth agricultural educational**
2 **program per fiscal year, the purchasing agency must comply with**
3 **the applicable federal procurement requirements.**
