A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning human services.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

8	(c) The legislative council is urged to assign to the appropriate
9	study committee during the 2021 interim the task of studying
0	Indiana's mental health hospital system, including the following:
1	(1) The need for state operated mental health hospitals in
2	Indiana.
3	(2) The capacity of the mental health hospitals.
4	(3) The wait time to receive inpatient services from the mental
5	health hospitals.
6	(4) The geographic availability of the mental health hospitals.
7	(5) The role and capacity of community mental health centers
8	to provide inpatient mental health services.



1	(6) Any changes that are needed to improve Indiana's mental
2	health hospital system.
3	(d) If an appropriate study committee is assigned the topics
4	described under subsection (c), the study committee shall issue to
5	the legislative council a final report containing the study
6	committee's findings and recommendations, including any
7	recommended legislation concerning the topics, in an electronic
8	format under IC 5-14-6 not later than November 1, 2021.
9	(e) This SECTION expires December 31, 2021.
10	SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.
