DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 20-35-13.

Synopsis: School based occupational and physical therapists. Provides that if a school corporation employs or contracts with: (1) an occupational therapist to provide occupational therapy services; or (2) a physical therapist to provide physical therapy services; to students with a disability, the school corporation shall ensure that the maximum student to therapist caseload does not exceed fifty (50) students per each full-time therapist. Requires consent before occupational or physical therapy services may be provided.

Effective: July 1, 2023.

Sec. 4. (a) If a school corporation employs or contracts with a physical therapist to provide physical therapy services to a student with a disability, the school corporation shall ensure that the maximum student to physical therapist caseload does not exceed fifty (50) students per each full-time physical therapist or a prorated equivalent for each part-time physical therapist.

(b) Nothing in this section allows a physical therapist to provide physical therapy services to a student with a disability without complying with the consent requirements under IC 16-36-1.
