

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1337

DIGEST OF HB 1337 (Updated February 22, 2024 12:46 pm - DI 87)

Citations Affected: IC 32-25.5.

Synopsis: HOA regulation of beekeeping. Provides that a homeowners association may regulate the number and location of beehives on properties. Provides that a homeowners association may not: (1) regulate the number and location of beehives that are located on a property before the regulations are adopted; and (2) prohibit beekeeping on property that complies with state law, if the beehives are actively maintained for pollination or production of honey.

Effective: July 1, 2024.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning property.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

20	(B) any rules adopted under IC 14-24-3.

COMMITTEE REPORT

Madam President: The Senate Committee on Local Government, to which was referred House Bill No. 1337, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

Page 1, delete lines 5 through 10, begin a new paragraph and insert:

- "Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "governing documents" has the meaning set forth in IC 32-25.5-2-3.
- Sec. 2. This chapter applies only to a homeowners association's adoption or amendment of governing documents after June 30, 2024.
- Sec. 3. Except as provided in section 4 of this chapter, and subject to section 6 of this chapter, a homeowners association may adopt or amend governing documents to regulate the:
 - (1) number; and
 - (2) location;

of active beehives that a person may maintain on a property that a person owns, rents, or leases.

- Sec. 4. This section applies only to a person who has active beehives located on a property before the date the homeowners association adopts or amends the governing documents. This chapter does not allow a homeowners association to prevent a person from maintaining the same:
 - (1) number; and
 - (2) location;

of active beehives that are on the property before the date the governing documents are adopted or amended.".

Page 1, line 11, delete "Sec. 2. Regulations adopted" and insert "Sec. 5. Any regulation".

Page 1, line 15, delete "3." and insert "6.".

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Page 1, line 16, delete "subject to covenants of the".

Page 1, line 17, delete "homeowners association".

Page 2, line 2, delete "for" and insert "for pollination or".
