

HOUSE BILL No. 1348

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: Administrative rules for veterans' programs. Requires that, by May 1, 2018, each state agency must review veterans' programs the agency is required to administer by state law and adopt emergency rules for any programs that have not yet been implemented.

Effective: Upon passage.

HOUSE BILL No. 1348

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning military and veterans.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) **As used in this**
2 **SECTION, "state agency" means any state administration, agency,**
3 **authority, board, bureau, commission, committee, council,**
4 **department, division, institution, office, service, or other similar**
5 **body of state government.**
6 (b) **Not later than May 1, 2018, each state agency shall do the**
7 **following:**
8 (1) **Review all veterans' programs required by state law to be**
9 **administered by the state agency.**
10 (2) **Adopt emergency rules in the manner provided under**
11 **IC 4-22-2-37.1 for any veterans' program required by state**
12 **law to be administered by the state agency that has not yet**
13 **been implemented.**
14 (c) **This SECTION expires December 31, 2018.**
15 SECTION 2. **An emergency is declared for this act.**
