DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 9-13-2-14; IC 9-21-8-5.

Synopsis: Vehicle clearance when overtaking a bicycle. Provides that it is a Class C infraction for the operator of a vehicle overtaking a bicycle to: (1) fail to allow at least three feet of clearance between the vehicle and the bicycle; or (2) return to the original lane before the vehicle is safely clear of the bicycle. Provides that the operator of a vehicle may pass a bicycle in a no passing zone if the operator complies with these requirements and it is otherwise safe to do so. Revises the definition of "bicycle" for purposes of the motor vehicle code.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

7	(3) having two (2) or more wheels. in contact with the ground.
8	The term does not include a child's ride-on toy or a skateboard.
9	SECTION 2. IC 9-21-8-5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
10	[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2018]: Sec. 5. The following rules govern the
11	overtaking and passing of vehicles proceeding in the same direction
12	subject to the limitations, exceptions, and special rules stated:
13	(1) A person who drives a vehicle overtaking another vehicle
14	proceeding in the same direction shall pass to the left of the other
15	vehicle at a safe distance and may not again drive to the right side
16	of the roadway until safely clear of the overtaken vehicle.
17	(2) Except when overtaking and passing on the right is permitted
