DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 20-20-36.3.

Synopsis: Circuit breaker property tax grants. Provides a grant to school corporations that have their transportation fund levies reduced by more than 40% because of the application of circuit breaker credits. Specifies that the amount of a grant is equal to the amount of circuit breaker credits granted against the school corporation's transportation fund levy for the year. Appropriates from the state general fund the amounts necessary to make the grants. Sunsets the law on July 1, 2021.

Effective: Upon passage.

1 chapter in a particular year if: 2 (1) for that year the school corporation's property tax levy for 3 its transportation fund is reduced, before the allocation of any credits under IC 6-1.1-20.6-9.9, by more than forty percent 4 5 (40%) because of the application of credits granted against 6 the school corporation's levy; and 7 (2) the school corporation submits to the department an 8 application requesting the grant. 9 (b) The department, with the assistance of the department of 10 local government finance, shall each year determine which school 11 corporations are entitled to a grant under this chapter. 12 (c) The amount of a grant to be distributed to an eligible school 13 corporation for a particular year is equal to the amount of credits 14 granted against the eligible school corporation's levy for its 15 transportation fund for the year. 16 (d) After June 30 but before September 1 of each year, the 17 department shall distribute to an eligible school corporation the 18 grant to which the eligible school corporation is entitled under this 19 chapter for the year. 20 Sec. 7. An emergency is declared for this act.
