# HOUSE BILL No. 1356

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 9-22-1.

**Synopsis:** Abandoned vehicles. Provides that an owner or last titled owner of a motor vehicle commits a Class C infraction when the owner or last titled owner of the motor vehicle abandons the vehicle. Requires a public agency that removes an abandoned vehicle earlier than allowed under statute to reimburse all costs paid by a person to release the vehicle from storage.

Effective: July 1, 2019.

### HOUSE BILL No. 1356

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 9-22-1-7.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2	AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3	1, 2019]: Sec. 7.5. (a) As used in this section, "record of sale" means

5	(1) A legible photocopy of a reassigned vehicle title.

8	(B) date of sale or transfer;
9	(C) driver's license number;
10	(D) name; and
11	(E) signature;

13	(b) This section does not apply to an owner under section 8 of
14	this chapter or the last titled owner of a vehicle who:

16	(A) possession of the vehicle; and
17	(B) the applicable certificate of title;



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1 to a subsequent purchaser or transferee; and 2 (2) possesses a record of sale for the vehicle that is delivered 3 to the subsequent purchaser or transferee. 4 (c) An owner under section 8 of this chapter or the last titled 5 owner who does not appear within the time specified to claim a 6 vehicle prior to a public sale under section 23 of this chapter 7 commits a Class C infraction. 8 SECTION 2. IC 9-22-1-11.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE 9 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 10 1, 2019]: Sec. 11.5. (a) A properly identified person who pays all 11 costs incurred against a vehicle or a part to release the vehicle or 12 part from storage under section 8 of this chapter may receive a 13 reimbursement of all costs paid under section 8 of this chapter if 14 the vehicle or part tagged under section 11 of this chapter is 15 removed prior to the period identified in section 11(3) of this 16 chapter. 17 (b) A person who qualifies for a reimbursement under 18 subsection (a) may request in writing a reimbursement from the 19 public agency named on the notice tag placed on the vehicle or part 20 under section 11 of this chapter. The request may be sent to the 21 address provided under section 11(1) of this chapter. 22 (c) A public agency that receives a request for reimbursement 23 under subsection (b) must reimburse all costs paid by the person 24 who qualifies for reimbursement under subsection (a).



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
