### **HOUSE BILL No. 1356**

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning insurance.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 27-1-43 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS

2	A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON
3	PASSAGE]:
4	Chapter 43. Indiana Health Benefit Exchange
5	Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "Affordable Care Act" refers to
6	the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act
7	(P.L. 111-148), as amended by the federal Health Care and
8	Education Reconciliation Act of 2010 (P.L. 111-152).
9	Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "exchange" refers to a health
10	benefit exchange established under the Affordable Care Act.
11	Sec. 3. (a) The department shall create a state exchange in
12	accordance with the broadest powers provided to the state under
13	the Affordable Care Act.
14	(b) The department shall take any actions necessary to
15	implement this section in a timely manner.
16	SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.



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
