9	Sec. 3. (a) The bureau shall provide a link to permits issued by
10	the department on the bureau web site.
11	(b) The link must be:
12	(1) included on the bureau's web site under the category of
13	online services; and
14	(2) clearly displayed and easily accessed.
15	Sec. 4. The bureau may adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 to
16	implement this chapter.
