DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 4-30-16-3; IC 8-23-31.

Synopsis: Matching fund for sidewalks and multi-use paths. Establishes the Indiana sidewalk and multi-use path program and matching fund (matching fund) to which eligible applicants may apply for grants to finance the construction of new sidewalks and multi-use paths. Specifies that the Indiana department of transportation shall administer the matching fund. Provides that \$5,000,000 shall be transferred from the administrative trust fund of the lottery to the matching fund in the state fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017, and that \$10,000,000 shall be transferred from the administrative trust fund of the lottery to the matching fund in each state fiscal year beginning after June 30, 2018. Continuously appropriates money in the matching fund.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning local government and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:
