# HOUSE BILL No. 1367

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 16-28.

**Synopsis:** Health facility requirements concerning residents. Requires a health facility to disclose to each prospective resident in writing information concerning the long term care ombudsman, including contact information for the long term care ombudsman. Requires a health facility to ensure that the health facility resident and at least one other described individual is present in the development and execution of a care plan for the resident.

Effective: July 1, 2019.

## HOUSE BILL No. 1367

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning health.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

2	AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3	1,2019]: Sec. 6.5. A health facility shall disclose to each prospective

7	concerning a health facility.
8	SECTION 2. IC 16-28-11-1.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
9	CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
10	[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2019]: Sec. 1.5. In developing and executing
11	a care plan for a health facility resident, the health facility shall
12	ensure that at least one (1) of the following individuals is present in
13	addition to the resident:
14	(1) A family member or relative designated by the resident.
15	(2) The resident's health care representative or guardian.
16	(3) Another individual designated by the resident.
