DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 7.1-5-12.

Synopsis: Restrictions on smoking and vaping. Provides that a person who smokes or vapes in a motor vehicle while a minor is present in the motor vehicle commits a Class B infraction. Enhances the penalty for the offense for certain prior offenses.

Effective: July 1, 2020.
