## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 12-17.2-7.2-11; IC 20-51; IC 20-51.4-2-4.

**Synopsis:** School scholarships. Amends the definition of "eligible choice scholarship student" for purposes of eligibility under the choice scholarship program. Amends the definition of "eligible student" for purposes of eligibility under the Indiana education scholarship account program.

Effective: Upon passage.
