## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** Noncode.

**Synopsis:** Appropriation for aviation education. Makes an appropriation from the state general fund to the department of transportation for the purposes of addressing the significant nationwide pilot shortage and providing opportunities in the fields of science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM). Provides funding to: (1) finish the interior of a new building at Indy South Greenwood Airport constructed to be used by youths in educational and training programs designed to promote aviation and careers in aviation; and (2) supply a training center associated with the educational and training programs with necessary equipment and teaching aids.

**Effective:** July 1, 2020.

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning transportation and to make an appropriation.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2020] (a) There is  
2 appropriated to the department of transportation six hundred  
3 thousand dollars (\$600,000) from the state general fund for the  
4 purposes of:  
5 (1) finishing the interior of a new building at Indy South  
6 Greenwood Airport constructed to be used by youths in  
7 educational and training programs designed to promote  
8 aviation and careers in aviation; and  
9 (2) supplying a training center associated with the educational  
10 and training programs described in subdivision (1) with  
11 necessary equipment and classroom teaching aids.  
12 (b) This SECTION expires June 30, 2022.
