DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: Appropriation for first responder monument. Makes an appropriation to the department of homeland security to facilitate the design, prototyping, fabrication, and installation of the American First Responders Memorial Monument.

Effective: July 1, 2020.

HOUSE BILL No. 1378

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning public safety and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2020] (a) There is
2 **appropriated to the department of homeland security established**
3 **by IC 10-19-2-1 three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000)**
4 **from the state general fund for the purpose of making**
5 **disbursements to Chainsaws for Charity and any other responsible**
6 **artisans and organizations to facilitate the design, prototyping,**
7 **fabrication, and installation of the American First Responders**
8 **Memorial Monument in the period beginning July 1, 2020, and**
9 **ending June 30, 2021.**
10 (b) This SECTION expires July 1, 2021.
