DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 12-15-13-9.

Synopsis: Medicaid reimbursement for tubal ligation study. Requires that, before August 1, 2019, the office of the secretary of family and social services (office of the secretary) study Medicaid reimbursement rates for tubal ligation procedures and sets forth requirements for the study. Requires the office of the secretary to present the results of the study to the budget committee before October 1, 2019.

HOUSE BILL No. 1380

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning Medicaid.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 12-15-13-9 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
1, 2019]: Sec. 9. (a) Before August 1, 2019, the office of the
secretary shall study Medicaid reimbursement rates for tubal
ligation procedures in each setting and circumstance in which the
procedure is provided.
(b) The study required by subsection (a) shall include the
following:
(1) The reimbursement rates by a managed care organization.
(2) An analysis and comparison of service rates and rate
structures for similar services in comparable states.
(3) An analysis and comparison of competitive market rates
and rate structures for similar services in Indiana.
(4) Recommendations for Medicaid rates for the procedure
for each setting or circumstance.
(5) The methodology for arriving at the recommended rates.
(c) The office of the secretary shall present the results of the



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- study to the budget committee before October 1, 2019. (d) This section expires January 1, 2020.
