DIGEST OF HB 1383 (Updated February 20, 2017 11:34 am - DI 116)

Citations Affected: IC 20-28.

Synopsis: Elementary school teachers. Provides that, not later than July 1, 2019, the state board of education shall adopt rules to establish one or more elementary school teacher content area licenses that must, at a minimum, include a content area license in the subject matter of math and science.

Effective: July 1, 2017.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

Page 1, line 6, delete "requiring" and insert "to establish one (1) or more".

Page 1, line 7, delete "an".

Page 1, line 7, delete "who initially receives a license under" and insert "content area licenses that must, at a minimum, include a content area license in math and science.".

Page 1, delete lines 8 through 11.
