

HOUSE BILL No. 1384

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 25-26-13-7.5.

Synopsis: Purchase of insulin needles. Provides that the Indiana board of pharmacy (board) may not establish limitations on the quantity of hypodermic syringes, needles, or insulin that may be dispensed to a patient or purchaser for the treatment of diabetes. Requires the board to amend an administrative rule.

Effective: July 1, 2022.

HOUSE BILL No. 1384

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning professions and occupations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 25-26-13-7.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
2 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2022]: **Sec. 7.5. The board may not establish**
4 **limitations on the quantity of:**

- 5 (1) hypodermic syringes;
 - 6 (2) needles; or
 - 7 (3) insulin;
- 8 **that may be dispensed to a patient or purchaser for the treatment**
9 **of diabetes.**

10 SECTION 2. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2022] (a) **The Indiana board**
11 **of pharmacy shall amend 856 IAC 2-6-18 to conform to**
12 **IC 25-26-13-7.5, as added by this act.**

13 (b) **In amending the rules as required by this SECTION, the**
14 **Indiana board of pharmacy may adopt emergency rules in the**
15 **manner provided by IC 4-22-2-37.1.**

16 (c) **Notwithstanding IC 4-22-2-37.1(g), an emergency rule**
17 **adopted by the Indiana board of pharmacy under this SECTION**



1 expires on the date on which a rule that supersedes the emergency
2 rule is adopted by the Indiana board of pharmacy under
3 IC 4-22-2-24 through IC 4-22-2-36.
4 (d) This SECTION expires July 1, 2024.
