## HOUSE BILL No. 1389

### DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 22-11-22.

**Synopsis:** Animal fire safety. Requires new construction at an animal facility to have a fire alarm system or staff on duty any time a dog or cat is present on the premises. Authorizes periodic local or state fire inspections to determine compliance.

Effective: July 1, 2023.

### **HOUSE BILL No. 1389**

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning labor and safety.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 22-11-22 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2	AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE

4	Chapter 22. Pet Fire Safety
5	Sec. 1. This chapter applies to new construction of an animal
6	facility that begins after June 30, 2023.
7	Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "animal facility" means any of
8	the following:
9	(1) An overnight animal boarding facility.
10	(2) A pet store.
11	(3) An animal care facility (as defined in IC 6-9-39-1).
12	(4) A veterinary hospital.
13	Sec. 3. As used in this chapter, "fire alarm system" means a
14	system that automatically sends notice of an alarm to a local fire or
15	police department when the alarm is activated.
16	Sec. 4. As used in this chapter, "overnight animal boarding
17	facility" means a business that houses dogs or cats overnight for a

2	Sec. 5. As used in this chapter, "pet store" means a retailer that
3	sells dogs or cats.
4	Sec. 6. New construction at an animal facility must have at least
5	one (1) of the following:
6	(1) A fire alarm system that is:
7	(A) designed by a fire alarm technician; and
8	(B) in operating condition.
9	(2) Staff on duty at the animal facility any time a dog or cat is
10	present on the premises.
11	Sec. 7. A fire department that has jurisdiction over the animal
12	facility or the department of homeland security may periodically
13	inspect an animal facility to determine compliance with this
14	chapter.
