DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 9-18.1-14-11.

Synopsis: All terrain vehicle safety. Specifies that an individual who is riding in a side by side off-road vehicle with a roll cage, and is properly fastened into and restrained by a child restraint system, is not required to wear a helmet.

Effective: July 1, 2019.


A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 9-18.1-14-11, AS ADDED BY P.L.141-2017,
SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
JULY 1, 2019]: Sec. 11. (a) As used in this section, "roll cage"
means a framework of reinforcements fitted around the passenger
compartment of a vehicle to protect the occupants from injury in
the event of a vehicle rollover.

(a) (b) Except as provided in subsection (c), an individual less than eighteen (18) years of age who is operating or riding on an off-road vehicle shall wear a helmet that meets the standards established by the United States Department of Transportation under 49 CFR 571.218 as in effect January 1, 1979.

- (c) An individual who is:
- (1) riding as a passenger on a side by side off-road vehicle that has a roll cage; and
- 15(2) properly fastened into and restrained by a child restraint16system according to the manufacturer's instructions, as
- 17 required under IC 9-19-11-2;
