## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 5-10.4-4-6.5.

**Synopsis:** Additional service credit for teacher mentoring. Provides that certain public school teachers who are members of the Indiana state teachers' retirement fund are granted additional service credit for serving as a mentor to other teachers under a mentoring program adopted by the school corporation that employs the mentor.

Effective: July 1, 2019.

## **HOUSE BILL No. 1399**

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning pensions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 5-10.4-4-6.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
2	CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3	[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2019]: Sec. 6.5. If a member:
4	(1) is employed as a teacher by a school corporation;
5	(2) is designated as a mentor under a mentoring program
6	adopted by the governing body of the school corporation;
7	(3) serves as a mentor to one (1) or more teachers under the
8	mentoring program; and
9	(4) the member is not otherwise compensated for the
0	member's service described under subdivision (3);
1	the member is granted additional service credit for the member's
2	service as a mentor equal to twenty-five hundredths (0.25) of the
3	service credit that the member is granted for the member's
4	employment as a teacher by the school corporation while serving
5	as a mentor.
