DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Synopsis: Classification of land with outdoor signs. Provides that certain outdoor signs shall be disregarded for the purpose of determining an assessment of the land on which the outdoor sign is located.

4	(B) if the sign site exceeds one-fourth (1/4) of an acre, the
5	area that is reasonably necessary to facilitate display of the
6	outdoor sign; and
7	(2) the subject matter of the outdoor sign relates to products,
