DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: Battery innovation funding. Appropriates \$3,350,000 for the upcoming biennium to the Indiana economic development corporation for lease payments for the battery innovation center located in Greene County.

Effective: July 1, 2015.

HOUSE BILL No. 1408

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning state and local administration and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2015] **(a) There is**
2 **appropriated from the state general fund three million three**
3 **hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$3,350,000) for the biennium**
4 **beginning July 1, 2015, to the Indiana economic development**
5 **corporation for lease payments for the battery innovation center**
6 **located in Greene County.**
7 **(b) This SECTION expires June 30, 2017.**
