DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 16-38-5-3.

Synopsis: Child care ministry immunization data access. Allows the state department of health to release to a child care ministry immunization data registry information concerning an individual enrolled in the child care ministry.

HOUSE BILL No. 1414

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning health.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 16-38-5-3, AS AMENDED BY P.L.122-2012, SECTION 7, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2014]: Sec. 3. (a) Records maintained as part of the immunization data registry are confidential.

(b) The state department may release information from the immunization data registry to the individual or to the individual's parent or guardian if the individual is less than eighteen (18) years of age.

(c) Subject to subsection (d), the state department may release information in the immunization data registry concerning an individual to the following persons or entities:

- (1) The immunization data registry of another state.
- 13 (2) A provider or a provider's designee.
- 14 (3) A local health department.
- 15 (4) An elementary or secondary school that is attended by the 16 individual.
