

# HOUSE BILL No. 1414

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## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 16-38-5-3.

**Synopsis:** Child care ministry immunization data access. Allows the state department of health to release to a child care ministry immunization data registry information concerning an individual enrolled in the child care ministry.

**Effective:** July 1, 2014.

## HOUSE BILL No. 1414

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A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning health.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 16-38-5-3, AS AMENDED BY P.L.122-2012,  
2 SECTION 7, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
3 JULY 1, 2014]: Sec. 3. (a) Records maintained as part of the  
4 immunization data registry are confidential.  
5 (b) The state department may release information from the  
6 immunization data registry to the individual or to the individual's  
7 parent or guardian if the individual is less than eighteen (18) years of  
8 age.  
9 (c) Subject to subsection (d), the state department may release  
10 information in the immunization data registry concerning an individual  
11 to the following persons or entities:  
12 (1) The immunization data registry of another state.  
13 (2) A provider or a provider's designee.  
14 (3) A local health department.  
15 (4) An elementary or secondary school that is attended by the  
16 individual.



- 1 (5) A child care center that is licensed under IC 12-17.2-4 in  
2 which the individual is enrolled.
- 3 **(6) A child care ministry that is registered under IC 12-17.2-6**  
4 **in which the individual is enrolled.**
- 5 ~~(6)~~ (7) The office of Medicaid policy and planning or a contractor  
6 of the office of Medicaid policy and planning.
- 7 ~~(7)~~ (8) A child placing agency licensed under IC 31-27.
- 8 ~~(8)~~ (9) A college or university (as defined in IC 21-7-13-10) that  
9 is attended by the individual.
- 10 (d) Before immunization data may be released to a person or an  
11 entity, the person or entity must enter into a data use agreement with  
12 the state department that provides that information that identifies a  
13 patient will not be released to any other person or entity without the  
14 written consent of the patient unless the release is to a person or entity  
15 described in subsection (c).
- 16 (e) The state department may release summary statistics regarding  
17 information in the immunization data registry to a person or entity that  
18 has entered into a data use agreement with the state department.
