A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning taxation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 6-3-2-1, AS AMENDED BY P.L.212-2018(ss).
2	SECTION 20, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3	JANUARY 1, 2021]: Sec. 1. (a) Each taxable year, a tax at the
4	following rate of adjusted gross income is imposed upon the adjusted
5	gross income of every resident person, and on that part of the adjusted
6	gross income derived from sources within Indiana of every nonresident
7	person:
8	(1) For taxable years beginning before January 1, 2015, three and
9	four-tenths percent (3.4%).
0	(2) For taxable years beginning after December 31, 2014, and
1	before January 1, 2017, three and three-tenths percent (3.3%).
2	(3) For taxable years beginning after December 31, 2016, and
3	before January 1, 2021, three and twenty-three hundredths
4	percent (3.23%).
5	(4) For taxable years beginning after December 31, 2020.
6	three and seven hundredths percent (3.07%).
7	(b) Except as provided in section 1.5 of this chapter (before its



1	expiration), each taxable year, a tax at the following rate of adjusted
2	gross income is imposed on that part of the adjusted gross income
3	derived from sources within Indiana of every corporation:
4	(1) Before July 1, 2012, eight and five-tenths percent (8.5%).
5	(2) After June 30, 2012, and before July 1, 2013, eight percent
6	(8.0%).
7	(3) After June 30, 2013, and before July 1, 2014, seven and
8	five-tenths percent (7.5%).
9	(4) After June 30, 2014, and before July 1, 2015, seven percent
10	(7.0%).
11	(5) After June 30, 2015, and before July 1, 2016, six and
12	five-tenths percent (6.5%).
13	(6) After June 30, 2016, and before July 1, 2017, six and
14	twenty-five hundredths percent (6.25%).
15	(7) After June 30, 2017, and before July 1, 2018, six percent
16	(6.0%).
17	(8) After June 30, 2018, and before July 1, 2019, five and
18	seventy-five hundredths percent (5.75%).
19	(9) After June 30, 2019, and before July 1, 2020, five and
20	five-tenths percent (5.5%).
21	(10) After June 30, 2020, and before July 1, 2021, five and
22	twenty-five hundredths percent (5.25%).
23	(11) After June 30, 2021, four and nine-tenths percent (4.9%).
24	(c) If for any taxable year a taxpayer is subject to different tax rates
25	under subsection (b), the taxpayer's tax rate for that taxable year is the
26	rate determined in the last STEP of the following STEPS:
27	STEP ONE: Multiply the number of days in the taxpayer's taxable
28	year that precede the day the rate changed by the rate in effect
29	before the rate change.
30	STEP TWO: Multiply the number of days in the taxpayer's
31	taxable year that follow the day before the rate changed by the
32	rate in effect after the rate change.
33	STEP THREE: Divide the sum of the amounts determined under
34	STEPS ONE and TWO by the number of days in the taxpayer's
35	tax period.
36	However, the rate determined under this subsection shall be rounded
37	to the nearest one-hundredth of one percent (0.01%).
