## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 7.1-3-21-13.

**Synopsis:** Restricted locations for temporary beer permits. Provides that the alcohol and tobacco commission shall not issue a temporary beer permit to a person for the express purpose of selling beer at a place that is within 100 feet of where an organized 4-H club has an exhibit (current law does not contain the distance restriction).

**Effective:** July 1, 2021.

Introduced

First Regular Session of the 122nd General Assembly (2021)

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning alcohol and tobacco.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 7.1-3-21-13 IS AMENDED TO READ AS  
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 13. ~~4-H Club Exhibits.~~  
3 The commission shall not issue a temporary beer permit to a person for  
4 the express purpose of selling beer at a place **that is within one**  
5 **hundred (100) feet of** where an organized 4-H club association has an  
6 exhibit.
