DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 22-2-19.

Synopsis: Veterans' benefits and services poster. Requires that the Indiana department of labor consult with the Indiana department of veterans' affairs to create and distribute a veterans' benefits and services poster. Provides that the veterans' benefits and services poster must contain certain information. Requires that Indiana employers with more than 50 full-time employees (or their equivalent) display the veterans' benefits and services poster in a conspicuous place.

Effective: July 1, 2024.
